## **MERIT BADGE PROCESS**

### **Learn, Test, Renew, Reward**

- Scout expresses interest in a merit badge.
- Scout determines who the appropriate merit badge counselor is from the approved merit badge counselor list located on troop 43's website.
- Scout obtains approval from the Scoutmaster and receives a blue card "Application for Merit Badge Card" with Scoutmaster's signature on it.
- Scout makes an appointment to meet merit badge counselor. Please let merit badge counselor know prior to any meeting that you would like to meet.
- If meeting takes place outside of a troop meeting, bring a buddy.
- Scout meets periodically with merit badge counselor and reviews merit badge pamphlet or worksheets and shares work completed to date.
- Scouts are expected to meet all of the requirements of the merit badge.
- Once merit badge is completed, have merit badge counselor sign the blue card and then review/discuss with the Scoutmaster for his approval and signature.
- When the blue card has the appropriate signatures, submit your paperwork to the Advancement Coordinator for recordkeeping and presentation of the merit badge.

6. SM will forward blue cards to the Troop Advancement Committee for recordkeeping and presentation of badge or Reward.

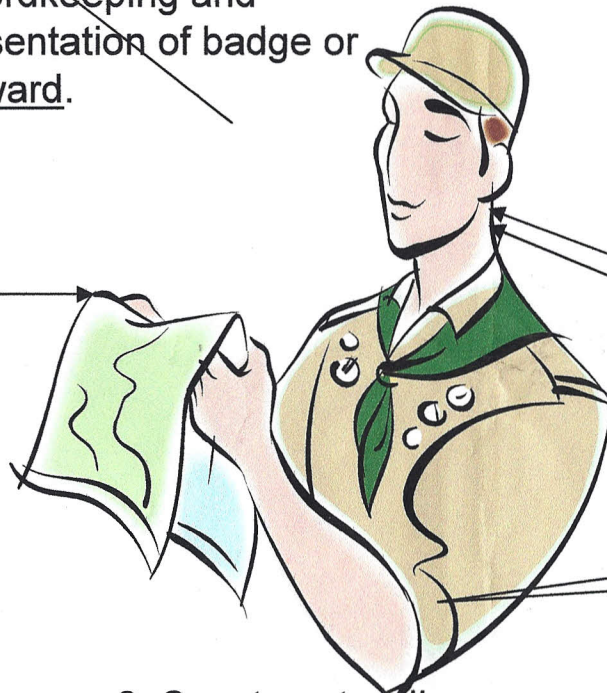


4. MBC works with the Scouts to establish a plan and timeline to complete the MB. Learn

After final testing for each Scout, MBC approves and returns blue cards to Scouts. MBC retains one-third; Scouts take two-thirds of their Blue Cards.



1. Scout expresses interest and seeks further information from Scoutmaster



2. Scoutmaster discusses interest and determines the appropriateness of the MB. If appropriate, gives MB Counselor information (*from the approved MB Counselor List*) to the Scout and signs a blue card.

5. Scouts request a meeting with their Scoutmaster to Review/discuss their MB work. If satisfactory work was submitted and reviewed, the SM will sign and approve.



3. Scout finds a buddy and contacts the MB Counselor. \*Buddy goes to Step 1.
